Rehearsal and Recital Information Sheet

DRESS REHEARSAL - June 5th - Part 1 and Part 2 (Full Show)

KLEINHANS MUSIC HALL

On dress rehearsal day, dancers and one chaperone per dancer are the only people allowed at Dress Rehearsal. All parents and guardians: please keep your dancer(s) near you and within sight. Dancers must be supervised at all times to minimize incidents of children getting into trouble, getting hurt and/or damaging the building and/or contents of Kleinhans. To help us prevent injury, please stop children from running. Running is not allowed in the auditorium aisles, foyer, halls, or stairways and is dangerous outside the building as well. Please report any incidents you may witness or hear of to our faculty or staff as soon as possible. We are obligated to remind you that food is not allowed in the auditorium. Please remove any and all wrappers, drinks or food items from the auditorium. Finally, dancers are not allowed to bring friends or other distractions to dress rehearsal, as well as studio rehearsals, as our teachers are working with our dancers during rehearsals and need to focus their attention to that end.

Studio Rehearsals

Studio rehearsals are held at South Buffalo Dance Academy. This is a simple run through of the lineup for dancers to prepare for performing and to know how the sequence of events will happen the day of the show. **NO COSTUMES ARE TO BE WORN AT STUDIO REHEARSAL.** Normal dance class attire is required. Please arrive on time as things can run quickly or run late and we don't want your dancer to miss their routine. One chaperone is allowed per young dancer if need. We prefer older dancers to be dropped off and picked up. Have your dancer bring a few bucks as there will be snacks and refreshments for sale!

PICTURE DAY IS DRESS REHEARSAL DAY

- All dancers must arrive at the rehearsal well groomed, with neat hair (consult style with teacher), make-up and with complete costumes.
- Use lots of hair spray and bobby pins and secure all hats and hairpieces so as not to distract the performance.
- After each dance is rehearsed, professional pictures will be taken.
- Every dancer must be in the class picture, even if not ordering class or individual pictures.
- Information sheets and order envelopes are available at South Buffalo Dance Academy and will be available at Kleinhans on June 5th as well. You will need an envelope for each routine you plan on purchasing pictures for.

*** Recital is on Sunday, June 12th at 2:00 PM sharp! ***

- **Curtain opens at 2:00 PM sharp!** Doors to the lobby will open @ 1:00pm.
Doors to the auditorium will open at 1:30pm, no earlier.
- **Dancers report at: 1:15 PM for Part 1** Dancers in Part 1 must be backstage before the show begins.
****1:30 for Tot dancers**-9**
2:00 PM for Part 2 Dancers in Part 2 can be in auditorium for part 1 but must be backstage when Intermission starts.
- On recital day, you are to drop your dancer off at the designated dancer drop-off door in the back of the building alongside the main parking lot. This will be marked with a sign and a staff member will be at the door to escort your dance backstage.
- Young dancers should be dressed in costume and ready to perform when dropped off. All other dancers should be dressed in their first routines costume and hair/makeup done as well.
- Only dancers are allowed backstage. We have plenty of volunteers and staff members to assist the dancers during the show. Everyone else including parents and spectators must enter at main entrance with a ticket. For younger dancers that we believe will need assistance with costume changes during the show, we will be contacting you privately (not till after dress rehearsal) to discuss how it will be handled and if we need your assistance backstage. If you are not contacted and are concerned about your dancers changes please let us know.
- Parking Fee – only on recital day is \$10.00. Street parking is an option.
- All dancers must be backstage before either part of the show begins – **Part I dancers at 1:15 (1:30 for tots) & Part 2 dancers at beginning of Intermission.**
- **Tot Dancers & younger dancers in only 1 routine dancing in part 1**, during intermission, will be escorted to the front of the stage for one adult to pick-up and return to their seat with them for part 2.
- During Intermission, **dancers only in part 2 that were seated in the audience**, must be escorted to the door right of the stage where a staff member will be located to take them backstage.
- At the end of the show, part 2 tot dancers and all other young dancers will be escorted into the front of the stage for one adult to pick them up. This makes it much easier to find your dancer and for us to keep track of them as they safely return back to you.
- Dancers must cover costume with robe or shirt when in the lobby or the auditorium before performing.
- Respecting the performers on stage, please enter and exit auditorium in between numbers only.
- SBDA Dancers: It is mandatory for dancers to stay for the entire show except 3-5 yr olds.
- Recital running time is about 3 to 3.5 hours.

*Each half of the recital is about 75 minutes long, with a refreshing intermission in between.
Cheer and applaud in support of all our dancers - it is greatly appreciated!*
